## **CALL FOR CONCEPTS**

Call for concepts are open for grants up to €400,000 for protected and conserved areas projects in the Pacific.







## **Eligible Activities**

Be located in one or more recognised protected or conserved areas, key biodiversity areas, community managed areas (e.g. CCAs or LMMAs) or sites committed to being designated as a future protected area(s).

Address clear priorities identified through a quantitative diagnostic tool (i.e.protected area management effectiveness or governance evaluation – PAME/PAGE). Note that any application not supported by a quantitative diagnostic tool will be automatically rejected.

## **Examples of Eligible Activities**

- Protected and/or conserved area planning and management activities
- Activities aimed at strengthening equitable governance
- Law enforcement activities, including wildlife trafficking controls
- Activities aimed at strengthening the institutional and legal framework/s in place
- Activities focusing on mitigating threats, including trial invasive species control
- Activities focusing on climate change mitigation, resilience and adaptation strategies in priority areas
- Activities aiming at improving sustainable livelihoods of local communities and / or vulnerable peoples
